Special Sunday worship, hike, picnic fellowship - Info & Directions

Aloha, CCAA Family & Friends,

Let's trust God to bless this coming Sunday with an amazing day of worship, recreation, and potluck picnic fellowship as I hope you'll begin the morning with us on the grounds of the Benedictine Monastery of Hawaii located on the slopes overlooking Waialua. [If you did not get a chance to sign up on Sunday, please rsvp to me and let me know if we are to expect you and how many there will be in your party.](#)

[Our schedule for the day is as follows:](#)

- * 8am - Carpoolers meet at Webling at 8am. Those leaving behind their vehicles should park on the street outside the gate.
- * 8:40am - Everyone meets at the Waialua High School parking lot to caravan up to the monastery grounds. Meet by/near the lot entrance if it is chained.
- * 9am - Arrive at the monastery's main parking lot and park in the section furthest away from the main building; our worship location is a 15 minute leisurely walk along a country path to a prayer grotto in the direction opposite from the building.

[NOTE: So as not to disrupt any of the Benedictine community's typical Sunday morning routine & worship, assume that we will NOT have access to their restrooms or water fountains until AFTER 11:20am. Please keep this in mind BEFORE you arrive at Waialua High School. 😊]

- * 9:30-10:45 - Outdoor worship service
 - * 11am-1pm - Hike to the cross (Group 1) or Set-up & begin picnic fellowship at Haleiwa Ali'i Beach Park (Group 2-Liz, Kim, et al)
 - * 1-3pm+ - Potluck picnic fellowship at Haleiwa Ali'i Beach Park
- [For those interested, North Shore beach time to follow until 5:00+ with location TBD]

Wear something comfortable for the outdoors and consider bringing the following items for your use and comfort (especially if you're planning to hike): cap, sunglasses, sunscreen, bug repellent, a cane/walking stick, water/liquids (equivalent of 2-4 water bottles), camera, snacks, a small knapsack, beach chairs & modest swimwear for the beach park, etc. And don't forget something ono to share with the gang at the potluck picnic lunch. We will plan to have some folding chairs available to set up at the worship site.

Finally, below are the directions to the monastery from Farrington Highway as found on their website. But again, since we'll be going "off the beaten path" once at the monastery, we would like everyone to caravan together from Waialua High School and move together.

The monastery is 2 miles on a private road off Farrington Highway. The road begins between Waialua High School and the Waialua Congregational Church. The road is paved for first 1/3rd mile until it passes Pioneer Products. It is unpaved for 1 mile until it reaches the first horse corral. Make a right turn to a paved road that proceeds westward by norfolk island pines. You pass through a gully, then through Stanhope Farms. The monastery property begins after the second group of horse corrals. Please park at the main parking lot to the right just below the pavilion, the large gray building with the red roof.

May God bless you and your family as you head into our Statehood weekend. And come Sunday, let's get together to enjoy sweet fellowship with God and each other in the midst of this island paradise of His!
